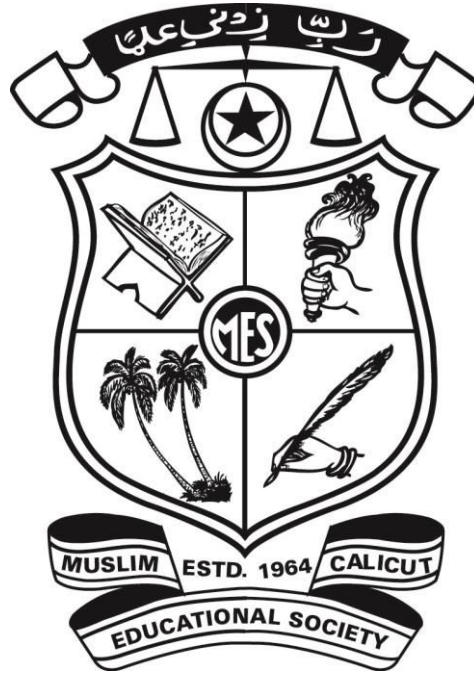

The Muslim Educational Society (Regd.), Calicut, in short MES, established in 1964, is one of the biggest Educational agency in India and has an active presence in the field of Minority welfare for the last five decades and is a driving force for the remarkable transformation of the educational status of the backward communities in Kerala. At present, the society is managing 160 institutions including Medical College, Dental College, Engineering Colleges, Architecture Colleges, Arts and Science Colleges, Nursing Colleges, Management Institutes, CBSE/State Syllabus Schools, Orphanages, Hospitals and Old Age Homes. MES MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL :

The MES Medical College, run by the Muslim Educational Society (Regd.), Calicut, is recognized by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, the Medical Council of India, Government of Kerala and is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences. It is a Muslim minority institution conferred by National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, Government of India under section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act 2004. The annual intake of the college is 100. The college has acquired the prestigious status of a Post Graduate Medical Institute with PG Courses in General Medicine, Paediatrics, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Pulmonary medicine, Psychiatry, Ophthalmology, Anaesthesiology, Dermatology, ENT, Radiology, Anatomy, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pathology, Pharmacology and Community Medicine. PG Diploma courses are also offered in Clinical Pathology. The College building comprises four storeys with a total floor area of 1,50,000 sq.ft. It has got full fledged pre and para-clinical departments with fully equipped laboratories, Air conditioned Lecture Theatres & Auditorium, well set exclusive Central Library with all latest technological devices to access electronic journals and online medical and health magazines. The college has the finest infrastructure for indoor and outdoor games. All academic modules including clinical training are supervised and administered

by eminent professors and experienced faculty members. The college has now emerged itself into a centre of academic excellence as is evidenced by laurels like university 1st Rank and many distinctions secured by MES Medicos competing with the other Medical colleges under the Government Sector as well as the Self-financing Sector. We have also a separate research wing fully engaged in carrying out medical research programmes systematically.

INTRODUCTION

- 1.1** This prospectus relates to admission to MBBS course for the academic year 2019-20 in MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna.
- 1.2** This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to MBBS Course in MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna for the academic year 2019-20.
- 1.3** This Prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the management of the MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna and will be subject to further orders, if any, passed by appropriate authorities/ Courts of law.
- 1.4** Total number of seats available for admission to MBBS Course in accordance with this prospectus and the categories into which such admission would be made, are given in Clause III and Annexure I below

1.5 Duration of Courses

Duration of the Course is 4 ½ years with a compulsory rotatory residential internship of 12 months. Internship training will include outreach community programmes and rotation postings of interns in the hospitals/health centres of the Muslim Educational Society.

The date of commencement of the course and the last date of completion of admission process will be as per the time schedule fixed by the Government of India/Medical Council of India/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

I. CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AND SELECTION SCHEDULE

2.1 Nationality:-

Candidates must be Citizens of India/children or dependents of Non-Resident Indians. The candidates should also satisfy the conditions prescribed in the Prospectus.

2.2 Age:

He/she shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the MBBS Course.

2.3 Qualification / Academic

- a) Applicants must meet all the requirements stipulated by the MCI and Kerala University of Health Sciences for admission to MBBS course.
- b) "Candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in clause(2) regulation 4 of the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 of MCI and in addition must have obtained a minimum of marks at 50th percentile in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for the respective admission year for admission to MBBS/BDS courses. In respect of candidates belonging to the Scheduled castes, Scheduled Tribes or other backward classes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 50% and minimum marks obtained in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG) shall be at 40th percentile instead of 50th percentile.

- c) The eligibility criteria for admission to NRI category will be as per GO(MS)No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013, G.O(Ms)No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014 and Notification No. CEE/5500/2017/KEAM-2018/TA1 dated 22-11-2017 of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala and further orders in this regard, if any, issued by government from time to time

Note:

- i. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of the qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health Sciences.
- ii. Candidates should possess certificate of good conduct and character issued from the institution last studied.

2.4 Reservation

- a) MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna is a Muslim minority institution conferred by National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, Government of India under section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act 2004. Hence 35 seats under management quota (ie. 35% of the total seats) are reserved for candidates belonging to the Muslim Community. The number of seats proposed to be reserved under various heads is detailed in Annexure I. Candidates claiming reservation should invariably produce community certificate obtained from the Revenue authorities concerned. If sufficient candidates are not available for seats reserved for management community, candidates from general category will be considered.

2.5 Schedule of Selection and Admission

Will be as per the time schedule fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala based on the time schedule fixed by the Medical Council of India/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

II. HOW TO APPLY

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, Government of India, as per letter dated 10-03-2017 directed the respective state government to conduct Common counseling for admission to UG and PG courses in all medical education institution in their respective state including private medical colleges/Deemed Universities. Hence application for admission to MBBS course in the college shall be submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala.

Note:

- Tuition fee for the first year shall be paid at the time of admission. The candidate must furnish bank guarantee for tuition fee for the subsequent years at the time of admission.
- Fees prescribed by the University/other statutory bodies (like exam fee, registration fee, etc.) and caution deposit shall be paid in addition by the students in actual from time to time.
- Besides tuition fees, caution deposit, Hostel & Mess fees and refundable deposit and any other fees as may be permitted to be collected will have to be paid extra.

IV. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION

Total MBBS seats i.e 100 seats in the MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, will be filled up by the college as allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list of candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG) for the respective admission year conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission to MBBS/BDS course, through common counseling as per letter dated 10-03-2017 of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & FW, New Delhi.

4.1 Preparation of common Merit list and Allotment of Seats

Rank list will be prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from among the applicant candidates who have qualified in the above NEET UG examination for the current admission year, based on the NEET rank secured by them after observing inter-se merit.

4.2 Publication of rank list and Allotment of Candidates: Rank list of candidates as detailed in clause 4.1 above will be prepared and published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and allotment will be done strictly on the basis of inter-se merit from the rank list so prepared.

There shall be only two rounds of Common Counselling by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The representative of the college shall be a part of the admission/counselling committee during the common counselling conducted by the CEE and shall check/verify the minority status of the candidate.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in MES Medical College and the college shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, documents to be submitted, and the amount of fees to be remitted at the time of admission.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the 2nd round of allotment list of students to be admitted in the college as per the schedule fixed by the Medical Council of India or such dates as may be fixed by the Government of India/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will not re-allot students already allotted to the College and admitted in the College, after this final allotment. The students must join the college as per the above-referred schedule, latest by 5 p.m.

If any student is not admitted by the Educational Agency for specific defects or for reasons to be recorded in writing, it shall intimate the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations/Government the defects or reasons as the case may be and the CEE/Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the college shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures but strictly as per the above-referred schedule.

The MES Medical College shall be entitled to fill those seats still remaining unfilled after 2nd round of allotment from the list forwarded by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the interim Judgment dated 09/05/17 in WP(C) No. 267/2017 filed by DAR-US-SLAM EDUCATIONAL TRUST AND ORS Vs Medical Council of India AND ORS. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations/Government shall not have any claim over such seats after the 2nd round of allotment and the forfeited seats shall not be brought forward to succeeding year for compensation.

In accordance with the Direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the interim Judgment dated 09/05/17 in WP(C) No. 267/2017, after 2 rounds of Counseling, the Commissioner For Entrance Examinations shall determine the number of seats that are still vacant and forward to the college a list of students in the order of merit equaling to ten times the number of vacant seats, so that in case of any stray vacancy arising in the college, the said seat can be filled up from the said list. If there arises still any vacancy, the same can be filled from candidates who have qualified in NEET UG 2019.

4.3 Furnishing of false information:

Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, if admitted, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

V. ADMISSION

5.1 The Managements will have the right to deny admission to any applicant on genuine grounds. In such cases, the reasons for the same will be recorded and communicated to the student concerned.

5.2 Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the tuition fee, other fees to be paid and bank guarantee for the subsequent years, failing which the offer of admission will stand cancelled. Candidates who get allotment shall appear before the Dean of the College and take admission at the appointed time and date and remit admission fee and special fees for the first year. They shall also produce the following documents in original at the time of admission before the Dean of the College:

- (a) Admit card of NEET UG -2019.
- (b) Result/Score Card of NEET UG -2019.
- (c) Mark list at the qualifying examination.
- (d) Pass Certificate of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- (e) Document (School Record viz: SSLC or equivalent) of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
- (f) Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE / ISCE.
- (g) A Physical Fitness Certificate in the format given in **Annexure III** obtained from a

Medical Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Medical Officer.

- (h) Course and conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
- (i) Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last attended.
- (j) Community certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable).
- (k) Non-creamy Layer certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable)
- (l) Income certificate issued by the competent authority (if applicable).
- (m) Originals of other certificates, the copies of which are enclosed with the application form.
- (n) Document/ certificate required in proof of any benefit claimed in the application form.
- (o) TWO sets of photocopies of all the above documents
- (p) Two stamp papers of Rs.200/- denomination each to be purchased in the name of candidate if he/she has completed 18 years of age at the time of admission. Otherwise stamp papers are to be purchased in the name of parent.
- (q) Passport size colour photo -10 nos.
- (r) A CD containing the same photo displaying name and date of birth of candidate at the bottom in JPEG format with 150x200 pixel dimensions.
- (s) Bank guarantee from a nationalized/scheduled bank for the amount of tuition fee to be paid for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th year of the course. (format given in **Annexure V**)
- (t) Undertaking in Annexure IV.
- (u) Any other document/ certificate required to be produced.

For NRI Quota, the following additional documents are to be submitted:

- a) Relationship certificate of the Sponsor and students to be issued by the Revenue Authorities as per GO(MS) No. 243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.
- b) Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer, attested by the Embassy and if self employed, it should also be attested by the Embassy. In the case of non-submission of Embassy Certificate, the endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment by the Embassy/Consulate shall be accepted. Certificate issued by the Embassy/Consulate stating that the Sponsor is a Non Resident Indian (NRI) or an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) or the Green Card documents shall be accepted in lieu of the Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer and attested by the Embassy.
- c) Passport with Visa stamped on it and attested by the Embassy
- d) A self affidavit of the relationship between sponsor and the candidate (Sponsorship Certificate)
- e) The sponsor should be an Indian Citizen/Overseas citizen of India/Person of Indian Origin and relevant document to prove the same

Note: Candidates will not be given any extension of time to produce the original documents/certificates and or for payment of fees or for production of bank guarantee.

5.3 Cancellation of admission/Refund of Fees

- (i). No request for refund of fees received within a period of five days prior to the date of closure of admission to the MBBS course fixed by the Medical Council of India will be entertained. Refund of fees will be applicable only to students who leave the College on or before five days before the last date for closing of admission for MBBS fixed by the Medical Council of India. The refund will be made within thirty days of the receipt of request thereof.
- (ii). If any candidate discontinues the course or leaves the Institution within a period of five days before the closing of admission in the 1st year or discontinues the course/leaves the institution in the subsequent years, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the remaining years i.e. fees for the whole course. In such cases the documents in original submitted by the candidate at the time of admission and other documents like Transfer Certificate in original to be issued by the college will be released only after payment of all dues including the fees for the remaining years.
- (iii). In addition to the above, such students will have to pay hostel, mess and other fees proportionately for the period they remained on the rolls of the college. For the purpose of calculations of proportionate recovery, part of a month will be considered as a full month.

5.4 Ragging

Important : According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.

All institutions will have to abide by the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India, dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No.(s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principal's, College, Kerala & Ors [with SLP (C) No.24296-99/2004 & W.P.(CrI) No.173/2006 & SLP (C) No.14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Honorable Supreme Court of India for effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions.

In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/ she indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/ she shall be expelled from the educational institution.

Each of the student of the institution and his/ her parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration/ admission in prescribed format available in **Annexure IV** which is mandatory for registration/ admission.

Such an undertaking shall be submitted before the commencement of every academic year. An undertaking similar to the above shall be submitted every year by the student who is admitted to the hostel.

5.5 Uniform & Dress Code

Students are expected to obey the dress code of the College. Jeans, Baggies T-Shirts and the likes are not permitted to be worn inside the hospital/College. All the male students are expected to wear formal pants, shirts and shoes. The female students are expected to wear saree and blouse with sleeves / loose fitting churidar with sleeves. They should

also wear shawl. Face veil is not permitted in the class rooms and during clinical work as well as inside the college campus. All the students should wear overcoat and ID card compulsorily. All students shall ensure modesty in dressing in the Campus. Students are not allowed to attend the classes wearing garments which fully cover the face. The management reserves the right to take appropriate disciplinary action against those who do not comply with the college dress code (vide judgement of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in W.P.(C).No.35293 of 2018 dated 04-12-2018).

VI. SERVICE BOND

All candidate shall undergo one year service as Resident Medical Officer/Junior Resident in MES Medical College or allied institutions of Muslim Educational Society as may be required by the Management and for that they shall execute a bond to that effect along with their parents/ guardian inter alia containing an unconditional undertaking that in the event of failure they shall pay a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) as liquidated damages to the college and further that the college will be entitled to retain all original certificates of the candidate submitted at the time of admission and other documents to be issued by the College on completion of the course till the said amount is paid to the College.

VII. GENERAL

- a) No TA or other allowance will be paid for any purpose connected with Selection and Admission.
- b) All candidates who are selected for admission should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis before admission. A certificate to this effect will have to be produced at the time of admission/before commencement of the course.
- c) Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college www.mesam.com regularly for announcements and instructions. No separate communication will be sent in this connection.
- d) Medium of instruction will be English.
- e) Any other matters not specifically covered in this Prospectus shall be decided by the management of the MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna and the decision of that authority shall be final and binding on all concerned.

VIII. REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES

Any grievances/ complaints regarding selection and admission can be brought to the notice of the management of the MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna within 24 hours of occurrence of the grievance.
